BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
    SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 5-56-101 is amended by inserting an additional
subsection at the end thereof to read as follows:
    "(c) As used in this chapter the term _food coupon_ means any printed
material, magnetically encoded instrument or other device or process issued by
the Department of Human Services, or its successors, the purpose of which is
to permit the purchase of food as provided for by the Federal Food Stamp Act
(7 U.S.C. 2011 et seq.) or regulations promulgated pursuant thereto."
SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.
