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25	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 26-18-303(b)(10) is amended to read as
26	follows:
27	"(10) In order to insure proper payment to vendors by all agencies of
28	state government, or by county governments or city governments, information
29	about the receipt or nonreceipt of sales tax permits by vendors must be made
30	available by the director upon request by these agencies of state government
31	or by county governments or city governments. Therefore, notwithstanding any
32	provision of this chapter or any other law to the contrary, in instances where
33	state agencies, boards, commissions, and other branches of state government or
34	where county governments or city governments identify to the director the
35	identity of vendors receiving payments and ask the director whether these
36	vendors have been issued sales tax permits, the director shall answer these

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1 inquiries;"
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         SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 26-18-303(b) is amended by adding a new
 4 subdivision (12) to read as follows:
         "(12) Disclosure of the list required by Ark. Code Ann. § 3-2-205(e)(4)
 6 reporting to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Division and the Alcoholic
 7 Beverage Control Board those taxpayers who hold a permit to sell alcoholic
 8 beverages and who are delinquent in state taxes."
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         SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 26-18-303 is hereby amended to add a new
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11 subsection (h) to read as follows:
         "(h)(1) Upon the request of a county government or a city government,
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13 the Director of the Department of Finance and Administration shall provide a
14 list of vendors within the requesting county or city who hold permits issued
15 pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 26-52-201 et seq.
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               (2) Requests made pursuant to this section must be made in writing
17 by an official of the county government or city government prior to August 1
18 of the calendar year for which the list is requested.

               (3) Lists provided pursuant to the provisions of this section will
20 be made available following October 1 of the year requested and will be
21 compiled from the list of all valid sales tax permits holders within the
22 requesting county or city as of September 1 of the year requested.

               (4) A reasonable fee based upon the number of permit holders
24 within the requesting city or county may be charged for the permit search made
25 and reported to the requesting county or city government.
               (5) Fees collected under the provisions of this section shall be
26
27 deposited in the Central Services Fund to be treated as a refund of
28 expenditures to reimburse the Department of Finance and Administration for the
29 costs of providing the requested information."

         SECTION 4. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
32 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
33 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
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35 SECTION 5. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to

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1 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
 2 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
 3 the invalid provision or application, and to this and the provisions of this
 4 act are declared to be severable.
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         SECTION 6. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
