L8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20	SECTION 1. The General Assembly finds that there are areas within
21	adjoining counties that are so necessary to the satisfactory conducting of a
22	city's business that there is a need to annex land lying in the adjoining
23	county into the city. This law will aid the residents to receive needed
24	services to improve the quality of life in the unincorporated area.
25	
26	SECTION 2. Any lands contiguous to a municipality having a population
27	of 75,000 or less, although located in an adjoining county, may become annexed
28	to the municipality in the manner provided in this chapter.
29	
30	SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
31	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
32	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
33	
34	SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
35	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
36	other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without

1 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
 2 act are declared to be severable.
         SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
