19	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 26-60-110(b) is amended to read as follows:
20	"(b) The county recorder of deeds shall not record any instrument
21	evidencing a transfer of title subject to this chapter unless:
22	(1) The instrument shall, at the time it is presented for
23	recording, have attached thereto or is accompanied by an affidavit in the form
24	provided in this chapter, containing the information required in this chapter
25	and have documentary stamps attached to the face of the instrument evidencing
26	full payment of the real property transfer tax on the transaction. The
27	instrument shall contain a notation on its face, which shall be recorded as
28	part of the instrument, that the affidavit was completed; or
29	(2)(A) In the alternative the instrument has stamped thereon or
30	attached thereto in a manner which will cause it to be recorded as a part of
31	the instrument the following statement:
32	_I certify under penalty of false swearing that the legally correct
33	amount of documentary stamps have been placed on this instrument
34	(B) This statement shall be signed by the grantee or his
35	agent, and the grantee's address shall be clearly shown on the instrument."

Arkansas Code 26-60-110 is amended by inserting an 2 3 additional subsection at the end thereof to read as follows: "(c) The county recorder of deeds shall not record any instrument 4 5 whereon documentary stamps are attached in such manner that the amount printed 6 on each stamp is not visible." 7 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent 8 9 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas 10 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 11 12 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 13 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 14 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 15 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 16 act are declared to be severable. 17 SECTION 5.
