Arkansas Code 20-22-301(a) is amended to read as follows: 24 25 "(a) The Arkansas Forestry Commission shall designate those employees 26 of the commission who shall have the powers of peace officers in the 27 enforcement of the fire laws, theft of property laws to the extent they apply 28 to theft of timber, and laws pertaining to the unlawful disposal of solid 29 waste when the unlawful disposal occurs on forest land." 30 31 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 32 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 33 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 34 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 35 36 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect

 3 act are declared to be severable.
