Subtitle<br>"TO MAKE AND DEFINE THE CHURNING OF<br>BUSINESS A TRADE PRACTICE VIOLATION."<br>BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

```
SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 23-66-206 is hereby amended by adding a new subsection (14) at the end of the existing section to read as follows:
" (14) _Churning of Business_is wherein the licensee replaces an existing policy of life and/or disability insurance and that replacement is not in accordance with § 23-66-307 or that replacement is without objective demonstration by the licensee of the purpose of replacing the policy for the benefit and betterment of the insured."
SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.
