22	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 14-171-203(3) is amended to read as follows:
23	"(3) _City_ means any city of the first or second class in this state
24	and also means the War Memorial Stadium Commission, the Arkansas Livestock and
25	Poultry Commission, and the Arkansas State Fair and Livestock Show
26	Association;"
27	
28	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 14-171-203(7) is amended to read as follows:
29	"(7) _Eligible facilities_ means any publicly owned tourist meeting
30	facilities or tourist entertainment facilities acquired or completed, or
31	substantially reconstructed or expanded, after December 31, 1974 and also
32	means War Memorial Stadium, and the facilities on the Arkansas State
33	Fairgrounds in Little Rock, Arkansas. Manufacturing facilities are
34	specifically excluded from this definition;"
35	
36	SECTION 3. Nothing in Arkansas Code 22-3-1009 shall prohibit the use of

1 funds provided under Arkansas Code 14-171-201, et seq. (The City-County
 2 Tourist Meeting and Entertainment Facilities Assistance Law) for eligible
 3 facilities as defined in this act.
         SECTION 4. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
 6 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
 7 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

         SECTION 5. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
10 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
11 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
