The surviving spouse of a deceased recipient of the 2 3 Congressional Medal of Honor shall be entitled to the special license plates 4 provided for in this subchapter and such plates shall be issued without charge 5 to the surviving spouse." 6 7 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 8 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 9 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 10 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 11 12 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 13 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 14 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 15 act are declared to be severable. 16 SECTION 5.
