It is hereby found and determined by the General Assembly 26 that Arkansas Code 14-15-803 provides that the treasurer of each county having 27 two judicial districts (with the exception of certain counties) must keep in 28 their office at each county seat the funds belonging to the school districts 29 and road districts of the respective judicial districts; that such provision 30 is obsolete and unduly burdensome upon those county treasurers; and this act 31 should immediately go into effect to eliminate that burden. 32 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this act being 33 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and 34 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and 35 approval.
