| 23 | SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 19-4-1604 is amended to read as follows: |
| 24 | "19-4-1604. Salary from two agencies. |
| 25 | (a) Except as provided in subsection (b), no person drawing a salary or |
| 26 | other compensation from one (1) state agency shall be paid salary or |
| 27 | compensation, other than actual expenses, from any other agency except upon |
| 28 | written certification to and approval by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State |
| 29 | and by the head of each agency, stating that: |
| 30 | (1) The work performed for the other agency does not interfere with the |
| 31 | proper and required performance of the person's duties; and |
| 32 | (2) The combined salary payments from the agencies do not exceed the |
| 33 | larger maximum annual salary of the line-item position authorized for either |
| 34 | agency from which the employee is being paid. |
| 35 | (b) This section does not prohibit state employees from contracting to |
| 36 | temporarily teach as adjunct faculty at a state supported institution of |

         SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
 6 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code

         SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to

10 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
11 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
12 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
13 act are declared to be severable.
