19	SECTION 1. Title 5, Chapter 73, Subchapter 1 is amended by inserting an
20	additional section at the end thereof to read as follows:
21	"5-73-131. Possession or use of weapons by incarcerated persons.
22	(a) A person commits the offense of possession or use of weapons by
23	incarcerated persons if, without approval of custodial authority, he uses,
24	possesses, makes, repairs, sells or otherwise deals in, any weapon, including
25	but not limited to any bomb, firearm, knife, or other implement for the
26	infliction of serious physical injury or death and which serves no common
27	lawful purpose, while incarcerated in the Arkansas Department of Correction,
28	Arkansas Department of Community Punishment, or a county or municipal jail or
29	detention facility.
30	(b) Possession or use of weapons by incarcerated persons is a Class D
31	felony.
32	(c) This section shall not be applicable to possession of a weapon by
33	
34	procedures in a jail facility after arrest."
35	SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
36	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code

         SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to

 4 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
 5 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
 6 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
 7 act are declared to be severable.
