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28	SECTION 1. The Director of the Arkansas S	tate Police is hereby	
29	designated as the Agent of the State of Arkansas for accepting surplus or		
30	excess Department of Defense property for the purpose of distributing the same		ame

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SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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5 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 6 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 7 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 8 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 9 act are declared to be severable.

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SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.

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SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General Assembly that there is presently no law designating a state government official to act as an intermediary between the Office of the Department of Defense Coordinator for Drug Enforcement Policy and Support and local law enforcement agencies for the purpose of transferring surplus Department of Defense property to local law enforcement agencies for counter-narcotics operations; that this act so provides; and that this act should go into effect immediately in order to facilitate the transfer of surplus Department of Defense property to local law enforcement agencies. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
