16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 17-98-301 is amended by adding the following
19	subsection:
20	"(c) The practice of massage therapy that is incidental to a program of
21	study by students enrolled in a registered massage therapy school approved by
22	the board is exempt from this chapter. The board shall adopt such rules and
23	regulations to authorize the students to perform massage under the direct
24	supervision of the school."
25	
26	SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
27	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
28	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
29	
30	SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
31	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
32	other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
33	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
34	act are declared to be severable.
35	
36	SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
