Arkansas Code 16-65-117(a)(1)(A) is amended to read as 23 follows: "(a)(1)(A) A judgment in the Supreme Court or chancery or circuit 24 25 courts of this state, and in the United States district courts or United 26 States bankruptcy courts within this state, shall be a lien on the real estate 27 owned by the defendant in the county in which the judgment was rendered from 28 the date of its rendition only if the clerk of the court which rendered the 29 judgment maintains a permanent office within the county, at which office 30 permanent records of the judgments of the court are continuously kept and 31 maintained, and the judgment has been filed with the circuit clerk. A 32 judgment in the municipal courts of this state shall not be a lien on the real 33 estate owned by the defendant in the county in which the judgment was rendered 34 until the judgment has been filed and indexed in the judgment records of the 35 circuit clerk in the county in which the judgment was rendered."

2	SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
3	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
4	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
5	
6	SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
7	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
8	other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
9	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
10	act are declared to be severable.

12	SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
13	hereby repealed.
