# A Bill

**ACT 484 OF 1995**  
**SENATE BILL 310**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR OPERATING EXPENSES  
9 FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND TOURISM WHICH SHALL BE  
10 SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED  
11 BY ACT 728 OF 1993; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

14 "AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND  
15 TOURISM SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the  
20 Department of Parks and Tourism, to be payable from the Department of Parks  
21 and Tourism Fund Account, for operating expenses of the Department of Parks  
22 and Tourism which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds  
23 appropriated in Section 3 of Act 728 of 1993, the following:

36 SECTION 2. FUNDING TRANSFER. Immediately upon the effective date of

1 this Act, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer on his books  
2 and those of the State Treasurer the sum of six hundred twenty five thousand  
3 one hundred six dollars (\$625,106) from the General Revenue Allotment Reserve  
4 Fund to the Department of Parks and Tourism Fund Account to provide funds for  
5 the appropriation provided herein.

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7         SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
8 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
9 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
10 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
11 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
12 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control  
13 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the  
14 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
15 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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17         SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
18 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
19 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which  
20 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
21 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
22 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
23 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
24 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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26         SECTION 5. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
27 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
28 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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30         SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
31 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
32 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
33 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
34 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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1 SECTION 7. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
2 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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4 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
5 Eightieth General Assembly that funds provided by the General Assembly for the  
6 operations of the Department of Parks and Tourism are, due to unforeseen  
7 circumstances, insufficient for the Department of Parks and Tourism to  
8 continue to provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of  
9 this act will provide the necessary monies for the Department of Parks and  
10 Tourism to continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date of  
11 this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and  
12 provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is  
13 hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate  
14 preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and  
15 effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
