#### Abstract

Subtitle "AN ACT TO CLASSIFY CREATURES OF THE CAMELIDAE FAMILY AS ALTERNATE LIVESTOCK."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 2-32-101 (a) is amended to read as follows:
"(a) All creatures of the ratite family that are not indigenous to this state, including but not limited to ostriches, emus, and rheas, and all creatures of the cervidae family that are not indigenous to this state, including but not limited to deer and elk, and all creatures of the camelidae family, including but not limited to llamas, alpacas, and guanacos, are hereby classified as alternate livestock."
SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.
