27	otherwise qualified therefor, may be issued a license to sell mortgagor's	
28	decreasing term life insurance, mortgagor's accident and health and sickness	
29	insurance, credit life insurance, credit accident, credit property, and credi	t
30	health and accident insurance, and to sell fixed or variable annuities."

32	SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent natur	е
33	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code	
34	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

36	SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to

1 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
 2 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
 3 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this

         SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
 7 hereby repealed.

         SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General
 9
10 Assembly that, as the result of the recent United States Supreme Court
11 decision in the case Nations Bank v. Variable Annuity Life Ins., Co., Arkansas
12 insurance laws prohibiting the sale of annuity products by lending
13 institutions and their subsidiaries and affiliates are in urgent need of
14 modification and clarification in order that Arkansas lending institutions
15 will not suffer a competitive disadvantage to foreign lending institutions,
16 and that this act is designed to modify and clarify such laws in order to
17 accomplish such purpose. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist
18 and this act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
19 peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its
20 passage and approval.
