Ark. Code Ann. § 13-2-705 is amended to read as follows: "13-2-705. Construction - Statistics. (a) No provision of this subchapter shall be construed to prohibit any 22 23 library or any business operating jointly with a library from disclosing 24 information for the purpose of (1) collecting overdue books, documents, films, 25 or other items or materials owned or otherwise belonging to such library; (2) 26 collecting fines on such overdue books, documents, films, or other items or 27 materials; and (3) contacting its patrons by telephone, mail service or other 28 medium for the purpose of notifying, informing and educating such patrons or 29 otherwise promoting the legitimate programs, policies and other interests of 30 the library. 31 (b) Aggregate statistics shown from registration and circulation records 32 with all personal identification removed may be released or used by a library 33 or library system for research or planning purposes." 34 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 35 36 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
