Any assistance rendered with any execution carried out 22 23 pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated § 5-4-617 by any licensed health care 24 professional, including but not limited to physicians, nurses and pharmacists, 25 shall not be cause for any disciplinary or corrective measures by any board or 26 commission created by the state or governed by state law which oversees or 27 regulates the practice of health care professionals, including but not limited 28 to, the Arkansas State Medical Board, Arkansas State Board of Nursing and 29 Arkansas State Board of Pharmacy. The infliction of the punishment of death 30 by administration of the required lethal substances in the manner required by 31 Arkansas Code Annotated § 5-4-617 shall not be construed to be the practice of 32 medicine. 33 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 34 35 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 36 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

1 2 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 3 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 4 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 5 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 6 act are declared to be severable. 7 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are 9 hereby repealed. 10 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General 11 12 Assembly that it may be necessary to carry out an execution at a date earlier 13 than the date this act would go into effect without an emergency clause; that 14 this act is vital in order to carry out executions as prescribed by present 15 law; and this act should therefore go into effect immediately.
