#### Abstract

Subtitle "TO PROVIDE THAT MUNICIPAL OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES MAY CONTINUE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE MUNICIPALITY_S HEALTH INSURANCE PLAN AFTER RETIREMENT."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:


SECTION 1. When any municipal official or municipal employee age fiftyfive (55) or over who is vested in the retirement system retires, the official or employee may continue to participate in the municipality_s health care plan as long as the official or employee pays both employer and employee contributions to the health care plan.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.
