BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 23-15-211(a) is amended to read as follows:
"(a) Any person who violates any provision of §23-15-209, or any
regulation issued under this subchapter, shall be subject to a civil penalty
of not to exceed twenty-five thousand dollars ($25,000) for each violation for
each day that the violation persists, except that the maximum civil penalty
shall not exceed five hundred thousand dollars ($500,000) for any related
series of violations."
SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.
