Subtitle<br>"AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A TWENTY-FIVE<br>DOLLARS (\$25.00) FEE TO HAVE A DRIVER'S<br>LICENSE REINSTATED FOR NON-DWI<br>OFFENSES."<br>BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The Office of Driver Services shall charge a fee of twentyfive dollars (\$25.00) for reinstating a driver's license suspended because of a conviction for any violation or offense other than a violation of §§5-65-103 or 5-65-303. All proceeds remitted to the Office of Driver Services pursuant to the provisions of this act shall be deposited to the Arkansas State Police Retirement Fund.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.
