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18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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20	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-17-1108 is amended to read as follows:
21	"6-17-1108. Committee - Powers and duties.
22	It shall be the function, power, and duty of the committee to:
23	(1) Consider and establish the policies which shall govern the

	eligible employees of public school districts as defined by this subchapter.
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30	(2) Employ an actuary to advise the committee on the implementation of
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35 36	<ul><li>Department;</li><li>(3) Institute an insurance or self-insurance disability insurance plan,</li></ul>
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1 or a combination of either type of plan. If the committee institutes a plan 2 of self-insurance, such plan will provide for hospitalization and medical 3 services which will best serve the needs of participating employees and 4 establish monthly premiums sufficient to pay claims, establish adequate 5 reserves, and pay the cost of an insurance company or service agency for the 6 processing of claims. The insurance company or service agency shall be 7 selected by the bid process outlined in this subchapter. Bid specifications 8 shall include the stipulation that the insurance company or service agency 9 shall provide consultant services to the committee as a part of the bid 10 quotation;

11 (4) In selecting the insurance carrier for a life or disability 12 insurance program, other than the self-insurance in subdivision (3) of this 13 section, select the policy with an insurance company authorized to do business 14 in the state which will best serve the needs of participating employees; 15 provided however, that the policy selected shall include criteria for uniform 16 evaluation of the coverage and benefits to be provided, as established by the 17 State Insurance Commissioner, to assure that there is a uniform basis for 18 interpreting and evaluating the policy coverage and the financial advantages 19 of each of the respective bid proposals based on the premiums to be charged 20 for the benefits in order to enable the committee to select the most 21 advantageous policy in terms of coverage and benefits commensurate with 22 premiums to be paid. Two (2) or more companies may join together for the 23 purpose of bidding. For the purpose of administration, one (1) paymaster must 24 be established for paying benefits under a bid by two (2) or more companies;

(5) Review the performance of the insurance company to insure that the best interests of the employees covered are being served, and such review review shall include a determination that the insurance company meets minimum financial standards for solvency and ability to provide services in accordance with evaluation criteria to be promulgated by the Insurance Commissioner as requirements to be met by insurance companies to be eligible to furnish life or disability insurance coverage for public school employees;

32 (6) Approve and review the proposals and recommend them to33 participating public school employees;

34 (7) Authorize an annual audit of the life and disability insurance 35 program, to be conducted by an auditor independent of the group insurance

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1 carrier and using procedures prescribed by the Division of Legislative Audit. 2 Findings of the audit shall be reported to the Legislative Joint Auditing 3 Committee; and (8) If deemed in the best interest of the participating employees, 4 5 institute a plan of self-insurance in life or disability insurance for 6 participating employees." 7 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 8 9 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 10 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 11 12 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 13 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 14 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 15 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 16 act are declared to be severable. 17 18 SECTION 4.
