## For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 17-14-203, CONCERNING CONTINUING EDUCATION FOR ARCHITECTS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle<br>"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 17-14-203<br>CONCERNING CONTINUING EDUCATION FOR<br>ARCHITECTS."<br>BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 17-14-203 is amended by adding the following new subsection (e) to read as follows:
"(e) The Arkansas State Board of Architects may adopt regulations setting minimum standards of continuing education to insure that all registered architects remain informed of those technical and professional subjects which the Board deems appropriate to professional architectural practice. The Board may by rules and regulations describe the methods by which such standards may be satisfied, and may provide that failure to satisfy such minimum standards shall be grounds for nonrenewal of an architect's certificate of registration."

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
