19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 14, Chapter 284, Subchapter 2 is amended
22	to add the following new section:
23	"14-284-225. (a) No property located within the bounds of a
24	municipality shall be assessed, taxed or required to pay fees to any fire
25	protection district after the effective date of this section unless:
26	(1) There is a mutual, formal agreement between the municipality
27	and the fire protection district to provide fire protection services to the
28	property; or
29	(2) Bonded indebtedness for fire protection equipment or
30	facilities was incurred by the fire protection district prior to the date of
31	annexation of such property, and the indebtedness incurred before annexation
32	has not been retired."
33	
34	SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
35	nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
36	Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

         SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
 2
 3 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
 4 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
 5 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
 6 act are declared to be severable.
 7
         SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
 9 hereby repealed.
10
         SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. It is found and determined by the General
11
12 Assembly that the provisions of this act need to be invoked to prevent undue
13 interference with the operations of fire protection districts and the fiscal
14 operations of county and municipal governments of Arkansas. Therefore, an
15 emergency is hereby declared to exist and this act being necessary for the
16 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full
17 force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
