22	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
24	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 17-14-102(5) is amended to read as follows:
25	"(5) The 'Practice of Architecture' means the provision or offering to
26	provide those services hereinafter described, in connection with the design
27	and construction, enlargement or alteration of a building or group of
28	buildings, and the space within and surrounding such buildings, which are
29	designed for human occupancy or habitation; the services referred to include
30	planning, providing preliminary studies, designs, drawings specifications, and
31	other technical submissions, and administration of construction contracts;
32	provided that the practice of architecture shall not include the practice of
33	engineering as defined in the Arkansas Engineering Act, Arkansas Code 17-27-
34	101 et seq. or the practice of contracting as defined in the Arkansas State
35	Licensing Law for Contractors, Arkansas Code 17-22-101; but a registered
36	architect may perform such engineering work as is incidental to the practice

1 of architecture, and an engineer may practice such architectural work as is
 2 incidental to the practice of engineering. The provisions of this chapter
 3 affirm the legal authority of an engineer licensed under the Arkansas
 4 Engineering Act, Arkansas Code 17-27-101 et seq. to provide consultation,
 5 investigation, evaluation, planning, and design of buildings intended for
 6 accomodation of equipment, vehicles, goods, and/or processes or other
 7 utilitarian function, with human occupancy including office space as required
 8 for the support of these functions, provided the engineer is practicing within
 9 his or her area of competency as defined in the Arkansas Engineering Act,
10 Arkansas Code 17-27-101 et seq."

         SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 17-14-302(a)(1) is amended to read as follows:

         "(1) Professional engineers duly licensed or registered, but only
13
14 insofar as concerns work incidental to engineering practice, providing such
15 persons do not use the designation 'architect' or any term derived therefrom;"

         SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
   are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
18 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

         SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
21 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
22 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
23 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
24 act are declared to be severable.

         SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
27 hereby repealed.
