17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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         SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 11-9-102(12) is amended to read as follows:
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         "(12) Employment means:
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         (A) Every employment in the state in which three (3) or more employees
22 are regularly employed by the same employer in the course of business, except:
         (i) An employee employed as a domestic servant in or about a private
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24 home:
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         (ii) An employee employed to do gardening, maintenance, repair,
26 remodeling, or similar work in or about the private home of the person
   employing the employee;
         (iii) Agricultural farm labor;
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         (iv) The State of Arkansas and each of the political subdivisions
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30 thereof, except as provided by §§ 6-17-1401 - 6-17-1405, 14-26-101 -
31 14-26-104, 14-60-101 - 14-60-104, 19-10-101 - 19-10-103, 19-10-202 -
32 19-10-210, 19-10-401 - 19-10-406, and 21-5-601 - 21-5-610;
         (v) A person for whom a rule of liability for injury or death arising
34 out of and in the course of employment is provided by the laws of the United
35 States;
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         (vi) A person performing services for any nonprofit religious,
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1 charitable, or relief organization; (vii) Any person engaged in the vending, selling, offering for sale, or 3 delivery directly to the general public of any newspapers, magazines, or 4 periodicals, or any person acting as sales agent or distributor as an 5 independent contractor of or for any newspaper, magazine, or periodical; (viii) Services performed by an individual if the individual is a 'qualified real estate agent' as that term is defined in § 3508 of the 8 Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended and as may be amended, including all 9 regulations thereunder. (B) Every employment in which two (2) or more employees are employed by 10 11 any person engaged in building or building repair work; Every employment in which one (1) or more employees are employed by 12 13 a contractor who subcontracts any part of his contract; 14 (D) Every employment in which one (1) or more employees are employed by 15 a subcontractor;" 16 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 11-9-102(10) is amended to read as follows: 17 "(10) 'Employee' means any person, including a minor, whether lawfully 18 19 or unlawfully employed in the service of an employer under any contract of 20 hire or apprenticeship, written or oral, expressed or implied; but excluding 21 one whose employment is casual and not in the course of the trade, business, 22 profession, or occupation of his employer, and excluding one who is required 23 to perform work for a municipality, county, or the state or federal government 24 upon being convicted of a criminal offense or while incarcerated. 25 'employee' shall also include a sole proprietor or a partner who devotes full 26 time to the proprietorship or partnership. However, any sole proprietor or 27 partner of a partnership who desires not to be included in the definition of 28 employee may file for and receive a certification of noncoverage under this 29 chapter from the commission. The term 'employee' shall not include any 30 individual who is a 'qualified real estate agent' as that term is defined in § 31 3508 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended and as may be amended,

32 including all regulations thereunder. A 'qualified real estate agent', as

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         SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
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11 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
12 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
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         SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
15 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
16 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
17 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
18 act are declared to be severable.
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         SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
21 hereby repealed.
