18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated § 20-13-807 is amended to read as
21	follows:
22	"20-13-807. Trauma Advisory Council.
23	(a) There is established an advisory council, to be known as the
24	_Trauma Advisory Council_, for the purpose of making recommendations,
25	advising, and providing assistance to the Division of Emergency Medical
26	Services of the Department of Health concerning the development of a statewide
27	trauma system.
28	(b) The advisory council shall consist of twelve (12) members who have
29	a demonstrated interest in trauma systems, to be appointed by the Governor as
30	follows:
31	(1) One (1) member appointed from a list of two (2) nominees
32	submitted by the Arkansas Chapter of the American College of Emergency
33	Physicians;
34	(2) One (1) member appointed from a list of two (2) nominees
35	submitted by the Arkansas Academy of Family Physicians;
36	(3) One (1) member appointed from a list of two (2) nominees

1 submitted by the Arkansas Chapter of the American College of Surgeons; (4) One (1) member appointed from a list of two (2) nominees 2 submitted by the Arkansas Medical Society; (5) One (1) member appointed from a list of two (2) nominees submitted by the Arkansas Hospital Association; 6 (6) One (1) member appointed from a list of two (2) nominees submitted by the Governor's Emergency Medical Services Advisory Council; (7) One (1) member appointed from a list of two (2) nominees 8 submitted by the Arkansas Emergency Nurses' Association; (8) One (1) member appointed from a list of two (2) nominees 10 submitted by the Arkansas Emergency Technicians' Association; 11 One (1) member appointed from a list of two (2) nominees 12 submitted by the Arkansas Ambulance Association; 13 14 (10) One (1) member appointed from a list of two (2) nominees 15 submitted by the Arkansas Emergency Medical Services for Children Program; 16 One (1) member appointed from a list of two (2) nominees submitted by the Arkansas Trauma Society; and 17 (12) One (1) member appointed from the public at large as a 18 consumer representative who has an interest in trauma systems. 19 The following shall also be members of the Trauma Advisory Council: 2.0 21 The Director of the Department of Human Services; The Director of the Highway Safety Program of the Arkansas State 2.2 23 Highway and Transportation Department; The Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police; 2.4 (3) 25 Two (2) senators appointed by the President Pro Tem of the 26 Senate; and Four (4) representatives appointed by the Speaker of the 2.7 28 House of Representatives." 29 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 30 31 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 32 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 33 If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 34

35 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
