         SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General

11 clarified immediately could result in undesirable forfeitures of property and
12 that this act is designed to correct this undesirable situation and should be
13 given effect immediately. Therefore an emergency is declared to exist and
14 this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace,
15 health and safety shall become effective on the date of its approval by the
16 Governor. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it
17 shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which
18 the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the

20 overrides the veto.
