BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
SECTION 1. The eastern boundary of Benton County is hereby extended to
include the following lands presently located in Carroll County:
(1) the lands lying West of the U. S. government take line for Beaver
Lake in Section 33, Township 20 North, Range 27 West, and
(2) the lands lying South and West of the U. S. government take line
for Beaver Lake in section 4, section 9, section 10, section 14, section 15
and section 16 of Township 19 North, Range 27 West.
SECTION 2. The lands transferred from Carroll County to Benton County by this act shall adopt the local option election status of Benton County.
SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
