    SECTION 1. (a) The Department of Human Services shall establish the
Donated Dental Services Program of Arkansas to coordinate the services of
volunteer dentists and dental laboratories who will provide comprehensive
dental care to needy, disabled, aged, and medically-compromised individuals.
    (b) The Department of Human Services may fulfill its obligations under
this act by awarding a grant for the administration of the Donated Dental
Services Program of Arkansas.
    (c) The Department of Human Services shall file a report with the
Legislative Council on the Donated Dental Services Program of Arkansas no
later than September 1 of each year.
    SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
    SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
act are declared to be severable.
