## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND  
10 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE ARKANSAS SENTENCING COMMISSION  
11 FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1999; AND FOR  
12 OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

14 "AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS SENTENCING  
15 COMMISSION APPROPRIATION FOR THE 1997-99  
16 BIENNIUM."

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
20

21 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the  
22 Arkansas Sentencing Commission for the 1997-99 biennium, the following maximum  
23 number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions  
24 of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201  
25 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided,  
26 however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set  
27 out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform  
28 Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions  
29 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular  
30 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its  
31 successor.

7 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Arkansas  
 8 Sentencing Commission for the 1997-99 biennium, the following maximum number  
 9 of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from  
 10 funds appropriated herein for such purposes: Two (2) temporary or part-time  
 11 employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the  
 12 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for  
 13 the appropriate classification.

14  
 15 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the  
 16 Arkansas Sentencing Commission, to be payable from the State General Services  
 17 Fund Account, for personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas  
 18 Sentencing Commission for the biennial period ending June 30, 1999, the  
 19 following:

 34 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
 35 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency

1 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
2 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
3 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
4 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control  
5 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the  
6 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
7 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

9 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
10 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
11 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which  
12 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
13 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
14 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
15 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
16 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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18 SECTION 6. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
19 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
20 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

22 SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
23 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
24 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
25 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
26 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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28 SECTION 8. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
29 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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31 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
32 Eighty-First General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas  
33 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that  
34 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1997 is essential to the operation of  
35 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in

1 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
2 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1997 could work irreparable harm upon the  
3 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
4 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
5 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
6 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1997.
