A Bill HOUSE BILL 1384
"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 27-15-901 TO PROVIDE FOR FREE PERMANENT MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSE PLATES FOR UNMARRIED SURVIVING SPOUSES OF PURPLE HEART MEDAL RECIPIENTS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."
"TO PROVIDE FOR FREE PERMANENT VEHICLE LICENSE PLATES FOR UNMARRIED SURVIVING SPOUSES OF PURPLE HEART MEDAL RECIPIENTS." "27-15-901. Eligibility and issuance.
(a) Each Arkansas resident who, while serving in the United States armed forces, was awarded a Purple Heart medal and has received an honorable discharge from the United States armed forces or the unmarried surviving spouse of any such Purple Heart medal recipient is entitled to register one (1) automobile, as defined by 8 27-14601(a) (1), or one (1) Class One truck, as defined by of 27-14$601(a)(3)(A)$, and receive a free special permanent Purple Heart license plate.
(b) (1) The license plate shall be issued by the Department of Finance and Administration upon application containing certification by the United States Department of Defense of the applicant's award of the Purple Heart recipient upon application accompanied by certification by
the United States Department of Defense that the deceased was a recipient of the Purple Heart medal and such proof as the Department of Finance and Administration may reasonably require that the applicant is the unmarried surviving spouse of the Purple Heart recipient.
(2) Any person desiring this special plate for more than one (1) motor vehicle may receive extra plates and shall be charged two dollars (\$2.00) for each motor vehicle."

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
