28	shall be posted universal da	anger signs on all sides of the sy	ystem, clearly	
29	visible to inmates and the public, displaying in English and Spanish the			
30	warning deadly voltage.			
31	(b) The installation of these fence systems shall be double, 12-foot			
32	high, security perimeter fer	nces, with the exception of those	locations whe	re a
33	building or wall constitutes a part of the security perimeter. At			
34	institutions where these fences have been installed, the department shall			
35	provide perimeter patrol for the safety of the local community."

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
 2 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
 3 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

         SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
 6 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
 7 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
 8 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
 9 act are declared to be severable.
