27	27 <u>25-1-105</u> , requires each state board or commission to file	with the Governor

1	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 15-22-505(3) is hereby repealed.
2	(3) To furnish to each regular session of the General Assembly a report
3	containing a complete accounting of all sums received and expended on water
4	development projects included in the Arkansas Water Plan, including economic
5	justification, based upon need, estimated costs, and feasibility of any such
6	project to be financed in whole or in part with state funds, and an outline of
7	benefits accruing to the state as a whole;
8	
9	SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
10	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
11	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
12	
13	SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
14	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
15	other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
16	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
17	act are declared to be severable.
18	
19	SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
20	hereby repealed.
