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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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         SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 14-59-105 is amended to read as follows:

         "14-59-105. Prenumbered checks - Electronic funds transfers.

         (a) All disbursements of municipal funds, except those described
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24 herein and as noted in ^{\circ} 14-59-106, petty cash funds, are to be made by
   prenumbered checks drawn upon the bank account of that municipality.
          (b) The checks shall be of the form normally provided by
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   commercial banking institutions and shall contain as a minimum the
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   following information:
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         (1) Date of issue;
         (2) Check number;
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         (3) Payee;
         (4) Amount both in numerical and written form; and
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         (5) Signature of authorized disbursing officer of the city.
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         (c) The municipality shall maintain printer's certificates as to
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35 the numerical sequence of checks printed.
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         (d) Disbursements of municipal funds used for payment of salaries
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1	and wages of municipal officials and employees may be made by electronic
2	funds transfer (EFT) provided that:
3	(1) the municipal employee or official responsible for such
4	disbursements shall maintain a ledger containing at least the name,
5	address and social security number of the employee receiving payment of
6	salary or wages; the routing number from the bank in which the funds are
7	held; the account number and the Accounts Clearing House trace number
8	pertaining to the transfer; the date and amount transferred and proof
9	that the employee has been notified of direct deposit of their salary or
10	wages by EFT, and;
11	(2) no such disbursement may be made by EFT without written
12	consent of the employee to whom direct deposit is made.
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14	SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
15	nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the
16	Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the
17	Code.
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19	SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application
20	thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity
21	shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can
22	be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to
23	this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.
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25	SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act
