24	or disbursed for the exclusive purpose of providing for benef	its, investme	nt_
25	management, and administrative expenses and shall not be encur	mbered for or	
26	diverted to any other purposes.

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2	SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are		
3	hereby repealed.		
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5	SECTION 5. Emergency. It is hereby found and determined by the Eighty-		
6	First General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the fiscal soundness of		
7	$\underline{ \text{the various retirement systems of cities and other political subdivisions of } \\$		
8	the state is vital to the operation of Arkansas governments; that the proper		
9	fiscal management of public retirement systems promotes the goal of good		
10	government and provides public employees with an incentive to perform		
11	efficiently and effectively; and that any delay in implementing a policy of		
12	sound fiscal management with regard to retirement systems of cities and other		
13	political subdivisions of the state could result in a financial disaster for		
14	any marginally financed retirement system in Arkansas. Therefore, an emergence		
15	is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the		
16	preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall become effective on		
17	the date of its approval by the Governor. If the bill is neither approved nor		
18	vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the		
19	period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is		
20	vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective		
21	on the date the last house overrides the veto.
