(b) Any person who violates the provisions of this section shall be 1 2 guilty of a Class D felony. 3 SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for a person to possess ephedrine, 5 pseudoephedrine or phenylpropanolamine, or their salts, optical isomers or 6 salts of optical isomers with intent to manufacture methamphetamine. Any 7 person who violates the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a Class 8 D felony. 9 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 10 11 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 12 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 13 14 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 15 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 16 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 17 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 18 act are declared to be severable. 19 20 SECTION 5.
