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17	SECTION 1. Title 28, Chapter 69 of the Arkansas Code i	s amended by	
18	adding a new subchapter to read as follows:		
19	" <u>28-69-701</u> . Short title.		
20	This subchapter may be cited as the Trustee Division of Trusts Act.		
21	28-69-702. Definitions.		
22	For purposes of this subchapter, unless the context otherwise requires:		
23	1. Trust means any express trust, with additions ther	eto, wherever	and
24	however created, or any separate share of a trust, and include	es any	
25	arrangement, other than an estate, which, although not a trus	t, has	
26	substantially the same effect as a trust.		
27	2. Trustee means an original, additional, or successo	r trustee of a	<u>an</u>
28	inter vivos or testamentary trust, whether or not appointed o	r confirmed by	y a
29	court, and, in the case of an arrangement which is not an est	ate or a trus	t <u>,</u>
30	but which has substantially the same effect as a trust, the p	erson in actua	<u>al</u>
31	or constructive possession of the property subject to such ar	rangement.	
32	28-69-703. Authority to divide trusts.		
33	Unless expressly prohibited by the terms of the governi	ng instrument	<u>′</u>
34	when property is held or to be held in a trust, the trustee i	s authorized,	but
35	not required, to divide the trust into two or more separate t	rusts, of equa	<u>al</u>
36	or unequal value, if the trustee determines that division of	the trust is	in

- 1 the best interests of the beneficiaries or could result in a significant
- 2 decrease in current or future federal income, gift, estate, or generation-
- 3 skipping transfer taxes, or any other tax.
- 4 28-69-704. Exercise of authority by trustee.
- 5 (a) A trustee may exercise the authority granted in this subchapter
- 6 without procuring any judicial authorization or approval.
- 7 (b) A trustee may exercise the authority granted in this subchapter to
- 8 divide both funded and unfunded trusts, provided, however, that:
- 9 (1) an unfunded testamentary trust may be divided only after the
- 10 will establishing the trust has been admitted to probate; and
- 11 (2) an unfunded nontestamentary trust may be divided only if the
- 12 governing instrument establishing the trust is not revocable.
- 13 28-69-705. Effect of exercise of authority.
- 14 If a trustee divides a trust into separate trusts under this subchapter,
- 15 the terms of the separate trusts need not be identical but must provide for
- 16 the same succession of interests and beneficiaries as are provided in the
- 17 original trust. Differing tax elections may be made for each of the separate
- 18 trusts.
- 19 28-69-706. Applicability.
- 20 This subchapter applies to all trustees regardless of whether the trust
- 21 was created before, on, or after date of enactment."

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- 23 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
- 24 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
- 25 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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- 27 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
- 28 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
- 29 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
- 30 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
- 31 act are declared to be severable.

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- 33 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
- 34 hereby repealed.
