## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND  
10 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE RICH MOUNTAIN COMMUNITY COLLEGE  
11 FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1999; AND FOR  
12 OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

14 "AN ACT FOR THE RICH MOUNTAIN COMMUNITY  
15 COLLEGE APPROPRIATION FOR THE 1997-99  
16 BIENNIUM."

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
20

21 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Rich  
22 Mountain Community College for the 1997-99 biennium, the following maximum  
23 number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions  
24 of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201  
25 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided,  
26 however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set  
27 out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform  
28 Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions  
29 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular  
30 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its  
31 successor.

SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Rich Mountain Community College for the 1997-99 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: twenty-five (25) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

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2 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS - GENERAL REVENUE. There is hereby  
3 appropriated, to the Rich Mountain Community College, to be payable from the  
4 Rich Mountain Community College Fund, for personal services and operating  
5 expenses of the Rich Mountain Community College for the biennial period ending  
6 June 30, 1999, the following:

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23 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATIONS - CASH FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated,  
24 to the Rich Mountain Community College, to be payable from cash funds as  
25 defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Rich Mountain Community College, for  
26 personal services and operating expenses of the Rich Mountain Community  
27 College for the biennial period ending June 30, 1999, the following:

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10 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
11 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
12 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
13 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
14 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
15 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditure Restrictions  
16 Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where  
17 applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and  
18 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in  
19 disbursement of said funds.

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21 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
22 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
23 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which  
24 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
25 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
26 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
27 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
28 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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30 SECTION 7. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
31 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
32 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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34 SECTION 8. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
35 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such

1 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
2 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
3 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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5 SECTION 9. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
6 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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8 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
9 Eighty-First General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas  
10 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that  
11 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1997 is essential to the operation of  
12 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
13 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
14 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1997 could work irreparable harm upon the  
15 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
16 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
17 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
18 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1997.
