"AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE HOUSE AND SENATE INTERIM COMMITTEES ON EDUCATION AND THE GENERAL EDUCATION DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, THE VOCATIONAL AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, AND THE DEPARTMENT OF HIGHER EDUCATION WILL COLLABORATE ROUTINELY AND CONTINUOUSLY THROUGHOUT THE BIENNIUM IN ORDER TO ASSURE THAT THE EDUCATIONAL NEEDS OF THE SCHOOL CHILDREN OF THIS STATE ARE PROVIDED FOR IN THE MOST TIMELY AND EFFICIENT ACTIONS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

WHEREAS, the imposition of term limits on members of the General Assembly make it imperative that there occur a routine and continual dialogue between the members of the General Assembly and the executive branch bureaucracy; and
WHEREAS, the funding and management of our public schools is a complicated and highly costly undertaking which necessitates a continual involvement by members of the General Assembly when not in session; and
WHEREAS, the best method of keeping the membership of the General Assembly informed as to needs and problems of our public schools is for the
```

House and Senate Interim Committees on Education to routinely and continually engage in a dialogue with the General Education Division of the Department of Education, the Vocational and Technical Education Division of the Department of Education, the Department of Higher Education and other state agencies which the committee deems appropriate.

NOW THEREFORE,
BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
SECTION 1. The House and Senate Interim Committees on Education shall continually and routinely between legislative sessions, assess the needs and problems of the public school districts of this state, vocational/technical institutions and institutions of higher education and engage in a constant dialogue with the General Education Division for the Department of Education, the Vocational and Technical Education Division of the Department of Education and the Department of Higher Education. In order to assist the General Assembly, the General Education Division for the Department of Education, the Vocational and Technical Education Division of the Department of Education and the Department of Higher Education shall not only respond to the inquiries of the House and Senate Education Committees, but shall of their own motion alert the membership of the committees to problems, needs, and recommendations of all public education endeavors in Arkansas.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
