9 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND  
10 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE MID-SOUTH COMMUNITY COLLEGE FOR  
11 THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1999; AND FOR OTHER  
12 PURPOSES."

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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21 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Mid-  
22 South Community College for the 1997-99 biennium, the following maximum number  
23 of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the  
24 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et  
25 seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however,  
26 that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein  
27 in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification  
28 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are  
29 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and  
30 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

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34 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Mid-  
 35 South Community College for the 1997-99 biennium, the following maximum number

1 of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from  
 2 funds appropriated herein for such purposes: two hundred (200) temporary or  
 3 part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided  
 4 in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this  
 5 act for the appropriate classification.

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7 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Mid-  
 8 South Community College, to be payable from the Mid-South Community College  
 9 Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Mid-South Community  
 10 College for the biennial period ending June 30, 1999, the following:

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28 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATIONS - CASH FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated,  
 29 to the Mid-South Community College, to be payable from cash funds as defined  
 30 by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Mid-South Community College, for personal  
 31 services and operating expenses of the Mid-South Community College for the

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14 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. PRIORITIES. A high priority of Mid-South  
 15 Community College shall be to combat illiteracy and to provide industrial  
 16 training in the work place.

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18 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. The appropriation level provided in  
 19 Section 3 of this Act shall not be construed as a commitment of the Arkansas  
 20 General Assembly to provide a particular level of support from the Work Force  
 21 2000 Development Fund for the Mid-South Community College, but rather that the  
 22 funds to be made available are to be based upon legitimate criteria and  
 23 accreditation requirements as determined by the State Board of Higher  
 24 Education for all technical colleges.

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26 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
 27 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
 28 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
 29 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
 30 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
 31 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditure Restrictions  
 32 Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where  
 33 applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and  
 34 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in  
 35 disbursement of said funds.

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SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 9. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 10. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 11. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 12. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Eighty-First General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1997 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1997 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1997.
