1	SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
2	hereby repealed.
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4	SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. It is found and determined by the General
5	Assembly of the State of Arkansas that public institutions of higher education
6	are in desperate need of additional funding; that one method of providing
7	additional funding is through the use of county sales and use taxes; that this
8	act authorizes the use of county sales and use taxes to be used in part for
9	capital improvements to and the maintenance and operations of public
10	institutions of higher education located within the county; and that this act
11	should go into effect as soon as possible in order to provide additional
12	revenues to the institutions of higher education as soon as possible.
13	Therefore, an emegency is declared to exist and this act being immediately
14	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall
15	become effective on the date of its approval by the Governor. If the bill is
16	neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the
17	expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill.
18	If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall
19	become effective on the date the last house overrides the veto.
