4	SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General
5	Assembly that the method prescribed by law for selecting the House cochairman
6	and House co-vice-chairman of the Joint Committee on Public Retirement and
7	Social Security Programs violates the rules of the House of Representatives;
8	that the selection of committee officers is an internal affair of the chamber
9	which should be addressed by rule; that the conflicting statutory provision
10	results in confusion and hampers the efficient operation of the House; that
11	this act will eliminate the conflict and make the law compatible with the
12	other laws relating to House committees; that clarification should be
13	accomplished as soon as possible in order to minimize disruption of the
14	operation of the committee during this regular session and hereafter.
15	Therefore an emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately
16	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall
17	become effective on the date of its approval by the Governor. If the bill is
18	neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the
