BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
```

SECTI ON 1. Arkansas Code 27-16-801(a)(2) is amended to read as follows:
"(2) Each Iicense shall incl ude:
(A) A di stingui shing number assigned to the licensee;
(B) The name, residence address (if the licensee is a law enforcement officer, at the officer's option the license shall disclose a post office box in lieu of the residence address), date of birth, and a brief description of the licensee; and
(C) A space upon which the licensee may affix his si gnat ure. "

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and perment nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revi si on Comission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTI ON 3. If any provision of this act or the application ther eof to any person or circunst ance is hel d i nval id, such invalidity shall not affect ot her provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the inval id provisi on or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are decl ared to be severable.

SECTI ON 4. All I aws and parts of I aws in conflict with this act are hereby repeal ed.
