13 "TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 26-54-105
14 PERTAINING TO FRANCHISE TAX REPORTS."
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17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 26-54-105(a) is amended to read as follows:

20 "(a) The Secretary of State shall furnish report forms to each
21 corporation subject to the provisions of this chapter by mailing them to the
22 corporation's ~~last known address on or before February 1 of each year~~ current
23 agent for service or other person identified by a corporation. When filing
24 the franchise tax report, a corporation may state who is to receive a
25 franchise tax form the following year, if that person is different from the
26 agent for service on file for the corporation at that time."
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28 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
29 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
30 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
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32 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
33 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
34 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
35 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
36 act are declared to be severable.

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SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
