## For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE OF 1987 ANNOTATED § 16-90-712 TO ALLOW CLAI MANTS SEEKI NG REPARATI ONS TO REPORT CRI M NALLY I NJ URI OUS CONDUCT TO THE PROPER AUTHORI TIES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES. "

## Subtitle

"TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE OF 1987 ANNOTATED
§ 16-90-712 TO ALLOW CLAI MANTS SEEKI NG
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## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTI ON 1. Arkansas Code $16-90-712$ is amended to read as follows:
"16-90-712. Conditions for reparations - Changes in awards.
(a) Reparations shall not be awarded:
(1) Unl ess the clai mas been filed with the board within one (1) year after the injury or death upon which the claimis based unl ess the board shall find good cause for the failure to file a timely cl aim
(2) To a clai mant who was the offender or an accomplice of the of fender ;
(3) To another person if the award would unj ustly benefit the of $f$ ender or accomplice;
(4) To a victim who is injured or killed while confined in state, county, or municipal jail, prison, or other correctional facility as a result of conviction of any crime;
(5) To any cl ai mant who has been convicted of a fel ony invol ving criminally injurious conduct;
(6) Unl ess the criminally injurious conduct resulting in injury or death was reported to law enforcement officer the proper authorities withi $n$ seventy-two (72) hours after its occurrence or the board finds there was good cause for the failure to report within that time or
(7) If there are insufficient funds in the Crime Victims Reparations Revol ving Fund. However, when sufficient funds become available, the awards which have not been paid shall be paidin chronol ogical order, with the ol dest paid first, unl ess the board shall find that compelling circunstances support a payment out of chronol ogi cal order. Any award hereunder is specifically not a claimagainst the state if it cannot be paid due to a lack of funds in the Crime Victims Reparations Revol ving Fund.
(b) Reparations otherwi se payable to a claimant shall be dimined to the extent:
(1) That the economic loss is recouped from collateral sources; or
(2) Of the degree of responsibility for the cause of the inj ury or death attributable to the victimas determined by the board.
(c) Upon finding that the claimant or victimhas not fully cooperated with appropriate Iaw enforcement agencies, the board may deny, withdraw, or reduce an award of reparations.
(d) On its own motion or on request of the cl ai mant, the board may reconsider a decision granting or denying an award or determining its amount. An order on reconsideration of anard shall not require a refund of amounts previ ously paid unl ess the award was obtai ned by fraud. Reconsideration does not affect the finality of a board decision for the purpose of judicial revi ew."

SECTI ON 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permant nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revi si on Comission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTI ON 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect ot her provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
the i nval id provi si on or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are decl ared to be severable.

SECTI ON 4. All I aws and parts of I aws in conflict with this act are hereby repeal ed.
