18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code §6-5-302 is hereby amended to read as follows:

22 "(a) From the monies accruing to the Educational Excellence Trust Fund, the
23 Treasurer of State on the last day of the month shall transfer to the various
24 funds and fund accounts listed below, the amounts determined by applying each
25 fund or fund account's proportionate part of the total of all such allocations
26 set forth herein to the amount available for distribution as determined in §6-
27 5-301:

26 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
 27 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
 28 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

29

30 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
 31 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
 32 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
 33 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
 34 act are declared to be severable.

35

36 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are

1 hereby repealed.

2

3 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
4 Eighty-second General Assembly, that changes in fiscal laws for the 1999-01
5 Biennium have to take effect on July 1, 1999 and that in the event of an
6 extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act
7 beyond July 1, 1999 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration
8 and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is
9 hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate
10 preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and
11 effect from and after July 1, 1999.
