4	branch organizations from a list of three (3) names submitted to him by each			
5	of the organizations.			
6	(c) The members of the commission shall serve without compensation.			
7	(d)(1) In carrying out its functions, the commission may create such			
8	advisory committees as it may deem necessary.			
9	(2) The memberships of these advisory committees may include bot			
10	members and staff of the commission, and other persons drawn from sources			
11	other than the commission, all of whom shall serve at the pleasure of the			
12	commission.			
13	(3) Members of such advisory committees shall serve without			
14	compensation for their membership on such committees.

16	SECTION 5. <u>Report.</u>			
17	The Task Force on Non-Baccalaureate Postsecondary Education shall submit			
18	a report and its recommendations for any proposed legislation to the Governor			
19	and the House Interim Committee on Education and the Senate Interim Committee			
20	on Education prior to March 1, 2000.			
21				
22	SECTION 6. <u>Staff support.</u>			
23	Staff support for the Task Force on Non-Baccal aureate Postsecondary			
24	Education shall be provided by the Arkansas Economic Development Commission			
25	and the Department of Workforce Education. Additional support shall be			
26	provided by all the appropriate agencies of state government upon written			
27	request of the commission.			
28				
29	SECTION 7. <u>Expiration.</u>			
30	The provisions of this act shall expire on January 1, 2001.			
31				
32	SECTION 8. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature			
33	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code			
34	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

26	SECTION Q. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
