2	SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
3	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
4	other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
5	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
6	act are declared to be severable.
7	
8	SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
9	hereby repealed.
10	
11	SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
12	Eighty-second General Assembly that the duties of combined office of sheriff-
13	tax collector in Izard County, Arkansas have become too burdensome for one (1)
14	person to continue to perform effectively, that the combined responsibilities
15	of both offices in Izard County have grown beyond the supervisory capacity of
16	one (1) person to continue to perform, and that it is necessary for this
17	combined office to be divided by law into two (2) separate offices with
18	exclusive responsibilities for different functions. Therefore, an emergency is
19	declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the
20	preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall become effective on
21	the date of its approval by the Governor. If the bill is neither approved nor
22	vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the
23	period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is
24	vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective
25	on the date the last house overrides the veto.
